Remember: No H-Bombs!

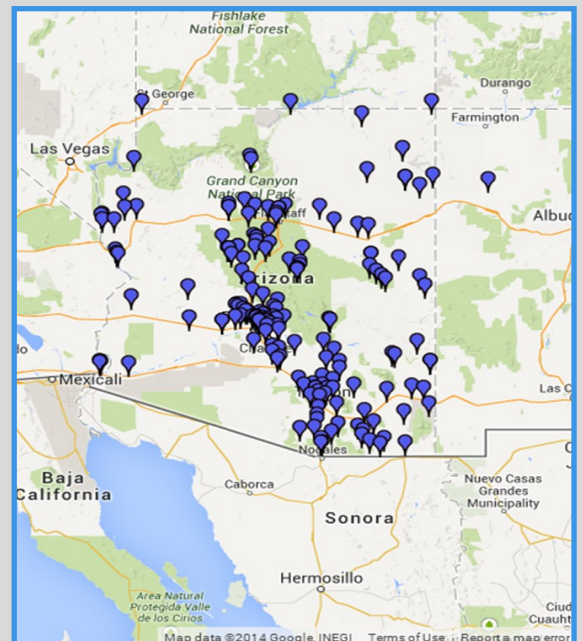
- ⇒ Hypoxia– put on high flow O₂ immediately
- ⇒ Hypotension-fluids if B/P low or falling
- ⇒ Hyperventilation-ETCO₂ target 40 (range 35-45)
- ⇒ Hypoglycemia-Check BS
- ⇒ Treat the injured brain well!

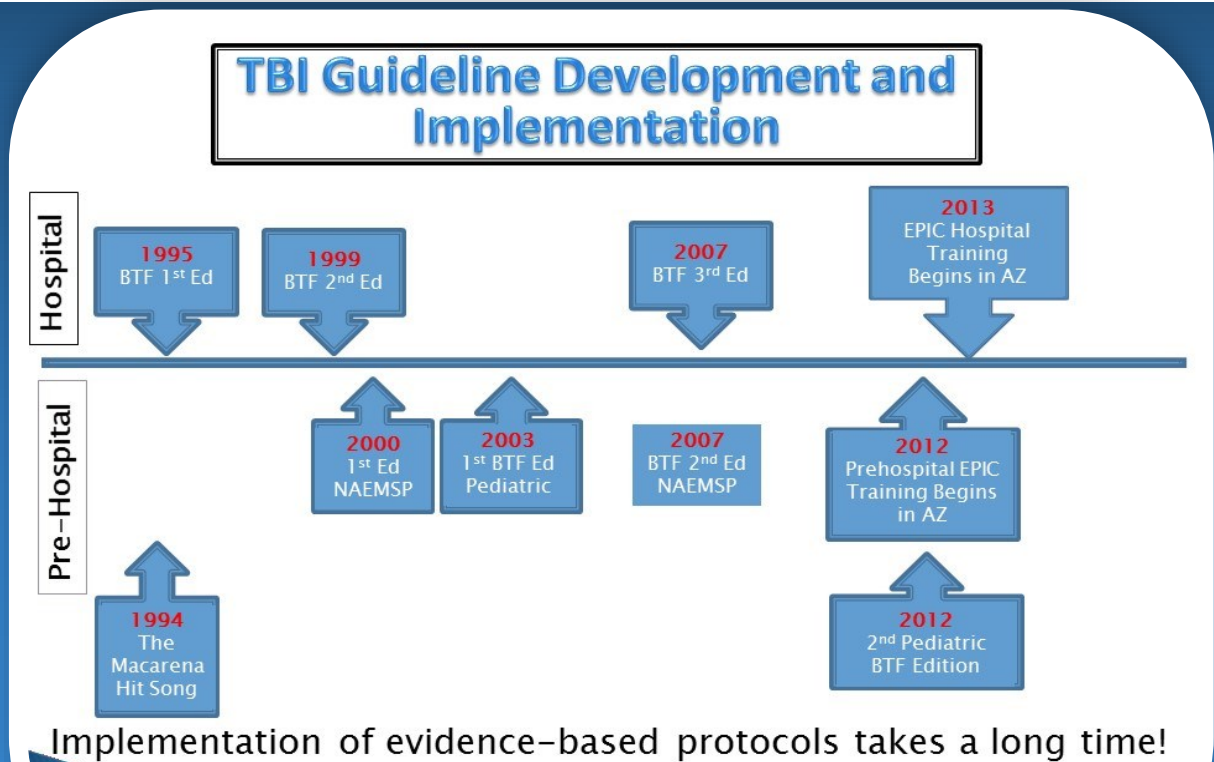

The first TBI guidelines were published when everyone was dancing to the Macarena.

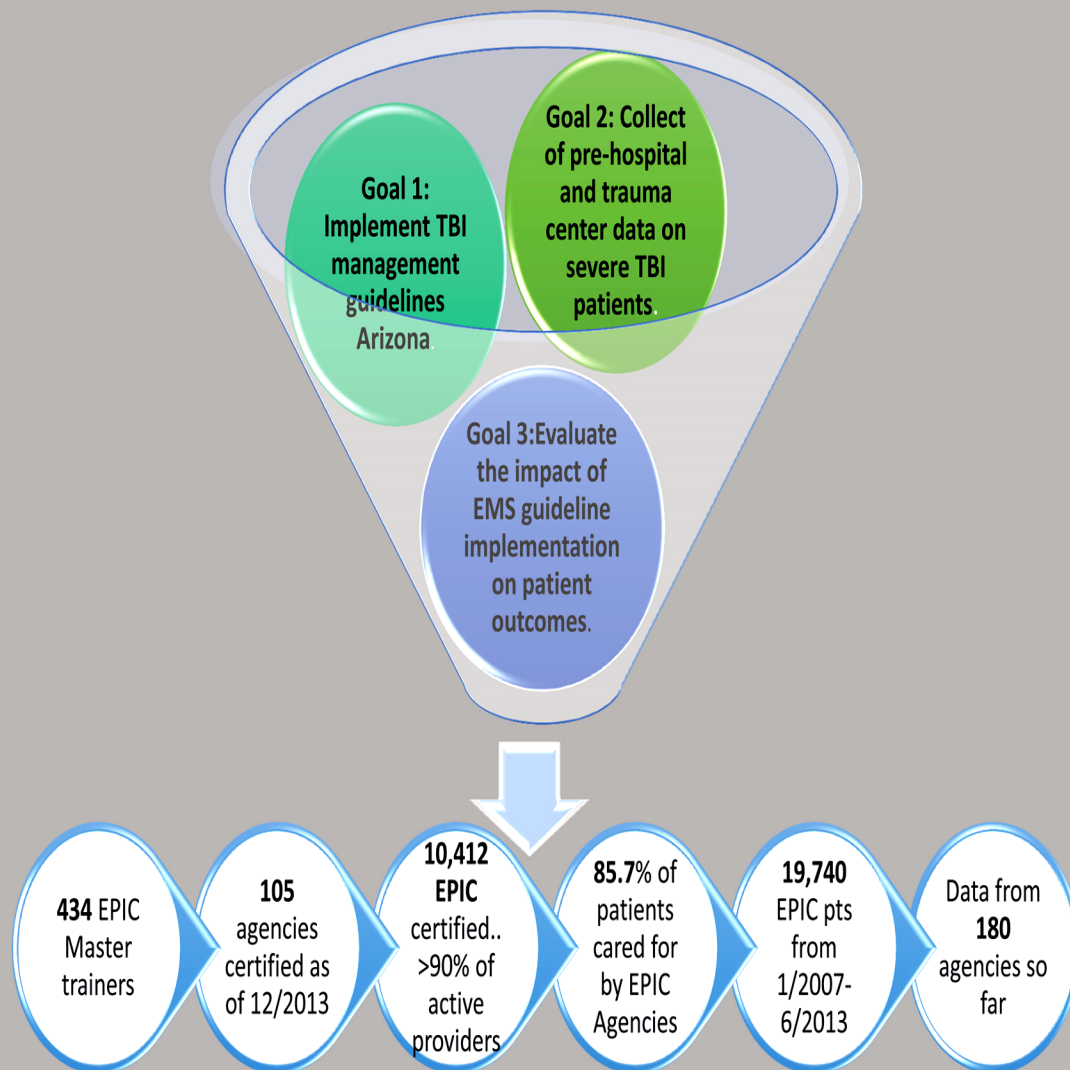
It has taken almost **20 years** to get these life-saving guidelines implemented in one state, and Arizona is the first!

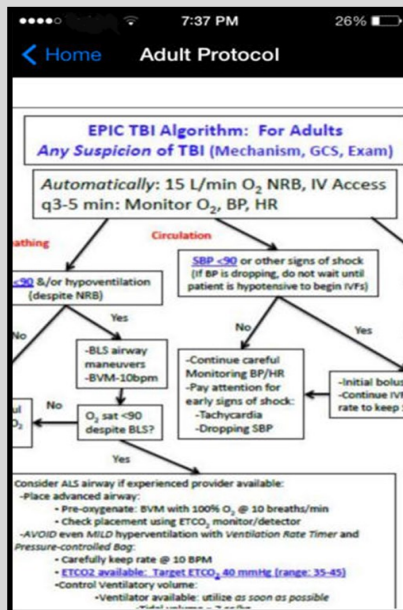
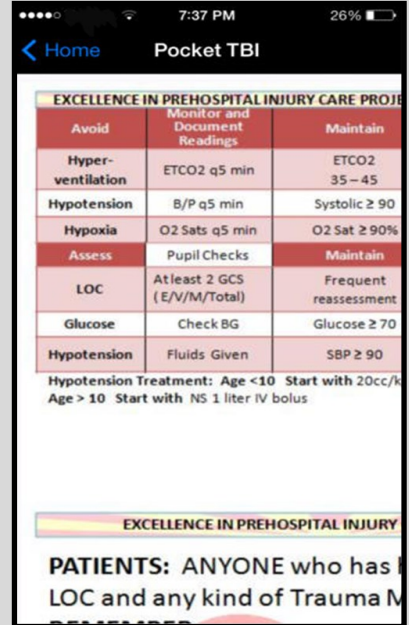
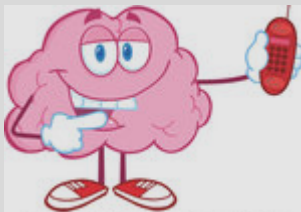
